MEETING TODAY'S FIRE SAFETY CHALLENGES IN CUSTODIAL FACILITIES

Custodial facilities around the world are faced with similar challenges in managing fire safety, with deliberately started fires, staffing shortages, smoke spread and attempts to tamper with equipment amongst the problems they face.

To address these challenges, Hydramist developed a range of water mist fire protection solutions specifically for the custodial sector.

How water mist fire protection works

Hydramist fire protection systems are the 21st century evolution of sprinkler systems. They use compact, high pressure water mist pumps to power water to water mist nozzles. The nozzles are selected based on the specific risk to be protected. When the pump is activated, the nozzles emit a fine mist of water that acts quickly and directly at the point of fire. The small droplet size creates a large surface area that rapidly cools the fire and surrounding surfaces. Water Mist penetrates deep into the fire and reaches areas that sprinklers find difficult to access, such as under furniture or hidden behind partitions. The fire is rapidly suppressed, and the cooling properties prevent reignition. Hydramist water mist systems are also proven to rapidly reduce the spread of smoke and toxic gases.

Water mist fire protection is now installed in over 90% of prisons in the UK. Police custody suites, courthouses, airport custody suites and detention facilities

One example of these systems is the Mobile8, which is ideal for fast deployment and ease of use. This all-in-one fire unit contains a pump, water tank, hose reel, lance and water mist nozzle. No installation is necessary. Staff only need to press the start button, insert the lance in the cell door and squeeze the trigger to rapidly suppress the fire without entering the cell.

Another fast and easy solution for smaller custodial facilities is the Hydramist Modular Hose Reel. This high pressure water mist hose reel is designed to easily fit into traditional hose reel cabinets.

The Modular Hose Reel includes a pump, motor, hose reel, lance and water mist nozzle. All that is needed are electrical and water supplies.

Automatic, fully-integrated solutions for larger prisons

For larger correctional facilities including prisons, Hydramist provides automatic in-cell protection powered by centralised water mist pumps. Anti-ligature water mist nozzles are located on the ceiling or wall of the cells. These systems have been used to protect some of the largest prison facilities in the UK.

Operational benefits for custodial staff and facilities managers:

The systems use approximately 80 percent less water than traditional sprinklers, which prevents cell flooding, eliminates the need for evacuation and only requires minimum clean-up after operation.
